

The Bible

The Bible is the Christians holy book. It is divided into two sections the old testament and the new testament.

The Bible is full of stories of different peoples lives and stories Jesus told as examples of how Christians should live their lives.



Holy Place

Christians worship in a church. They gather to sing, read the bible and learn more about Jesus.

Christians have special places all around the world for example Bethlehem where Jesus was born and Rome where the Pope lives.

<u>Symbols</u>

The main symbol of Christianity is the cross. It reminds Christians that Jesus suffered and died for them to give

them new life.

Water represents new life, the washing away of sins.

<u>Festivals</u>

Christians celebrate many festivals. The two most important are Christmas and Easter. Christmas is celebrating Jesus' Birth and Easter is celebrating the resurrection of Jesus after he died on the cross three days earlier.

<u>Pilgrimages</u>

A pilgrimage is a journey or search of moral or spiritual significance.

There are a few different places that Christians go on Pilgrimage to; Fatima and Lourdes are two examples.

Lourdes is a place in France that the Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus, blessed a young girl who was very sick. Many people travel here every year who are to be blessed and healed.


